CERTIFICATE OF CITIZENSHIP.

State of Pennsylvania, ss.
County of Westmoreland.

BE IT REMEMBERED, That at a Court of Common Pleas, held at Greensburg, for the County of Westmoreland, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the United States of America, on the *Second* day of *June* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *eighty eight*. *J. B. Bauer* a native of *Bavaria* exhibited a PETITION, praying to be admitted to become a citizen of the United States; and it appearing to the said Court, and the said *J. B. Bauer* having on his solemn oath declared, and also made proof thereof by competent testimony of *Andrew J. Allen*

citizens of the United States, that he had resided one year and upwards within the State of Pennsylvania, and within the United States of America for upwards of five years immediately preceding his application, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court, that during that time he had behaved as a man of good moral character, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same; and that he had in all things fully complied with the laws of the United States, in such case made and provided; and having declared on his solemn oath before the said Court, that he would support the Constitution of the United States, and that he did absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to *Frederick III Emperor of Germany* of whom he was before a subject. Thereupon the Court admitted the said *J. B. Bauer* a citizen of the United States of America, and ordered the proceedings aforesaid to be recorded by the Prothonotary of the said Court, which was done accordingly.
